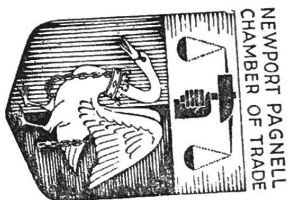



JAZZMEN AT NEWPORT

Ken Colyer must surely be the most established traditional jazz band leader in Britain today. His never deviating way of playing New Orleans jazz has won him fans from all age groups all over the world.

Born in Yarmouth in 1928 his first venture into the musical world was at the age of 14, playing the harmonica. Later, he joined the Merchant Navy and practised the trumpet during the 3½ years that he was at sea (sometimes to the great annoyance of his fellow crew members).

During a temporary respite from the sea he became the leader of a band featuring many names which are famous on the traditional jazz scene today. This band was called the Crane River Jazz Band, deriving its name from the area in which it was formed, namely Cranford, near London Airport.

After this Ken left the country again in the Merchant Navy and managed after many months, to achieve his ambition and visit New Orleans itself. It was here that he managed to sit in and play with the famous George Lewis Band, also meeting and playing with many other famous musicians whom he had admired for so many years.

On his return to England, Ken Colyer took over the leadership of a band which had such names as Christ Barber, Monty Sunshine and Lonnie Donnegan. After a few months Ken re-formed this band and the personnel had very few changes for the following five years.

Model Aerobatic Display

Since the end of the war, the building and flying of model aeroplanes has developed into a very popular sport, practised and enjoyed by many thousands of the population of all ages. It can be readily understood that model aircrafts are not toys, since they achieve what a comparatively few years ago was considered impossible.

The activities of aeromodels include the construction of non-flying highly detailed replicas of full size aeroplanes, models tethered by control lines which are designed either for speed, aerobatics or scale appearance, rubber powered models capable of flights of 5 minutes or more, free flight power model. Gliders and sail planes either free flight or radio controlled. Unorthodox models, such as space ships, flying saucers, hovercraft and helicopters. Radio controlled models which can be designed for either scale appearance or pleasure flying and aerobatics.

It is this section that we primarily hope to introduce to you and entertain you with this evening. Some members of the Bristol Radio Control Model Aircraft Club and other individual enthusiasts will be flying some advanced types of aerobatic machines.

We would point out that models of these sizes weighing from 5-10lbs. can travel at speeds of up to 70 or 80 miles per hour and can under certain circumstances be dangerous, and since they are costly items we would appreciate the co-operation of the public in all our requests.

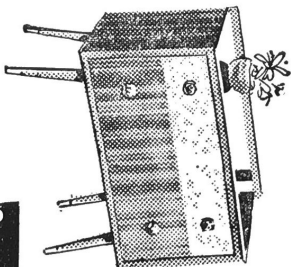

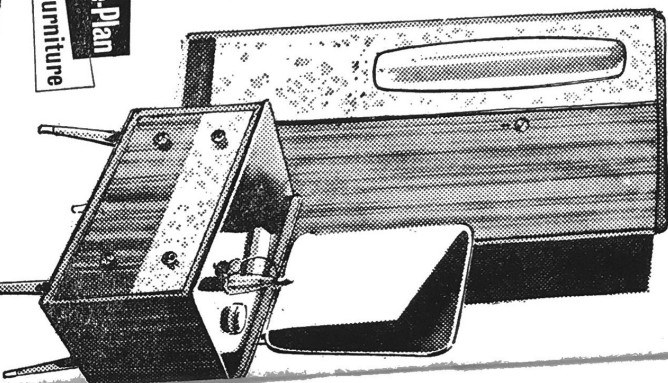

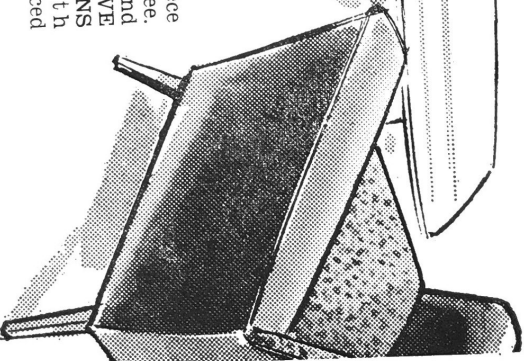
