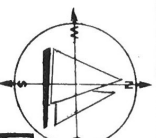

The White Helmets

(ROYAL SIGNALS MOTOR CYCLE DISPLAY TEAM)

The White Helmets, the world's original motor cycle display team, are celebrating their Golden Jubilee Season this year. Originally formed from despatch riders of the Royal Corps of Signals, the team now represents a variety of Royal Signals trades. The Royal Signals have always produced a display team which demonstrates the qualities of skill and courage required of despatch riders in two world wars, and the versatility of the Signalmen, be it in Ulster, or performing with the display team.

Today's team members have all volunteered to undergo selection tests and training, in Catterick and the surrounding Yorkshire moors, in order to spend three years as White Helmets. Before joining the Royal Signals, team members were in all walks of life, for about half it is their first experience of motorcycling, and for most it is their first taste of the military form of snow business.

After a winter of hard training in all weathers, the team has produced a display consisting of high speed cross-over rides, requiring split second timing and great confidence; feats of balance, with as many as twenty-two men on six machines, and ten men on a single motor cycle, and breathtaking spectacles, such as the fire jump and the famous space leap.

In recent years the team has toured the United States, Hong Kong, Canada, Monte Carlo, the Oman and most of Europe. This year will see them at many shows in the United Kingdom, including the Royal Tournament in this, the Royal Silver Jubilee year, and on the continent, ending the season with the British Berlin Tattoo.

This year's display is being led by Captain Mike Prymaka, Royal Signals, the Team Captain, with Lieutenant Geoff Powell, Royal Signals, as Team Adjutant. The Team Sergeant, returning after a few years away from the team, is Sergeant Roy Coffill.

Throughout the display, which will be seen by about two million spectators this year, as well as on television, you will see man and machine tested to the limit. Wherever you see us, we are sure that you will find the new tricks and rides exciting and spectacular, and that the old favourites from our last half century will be as popular as ever.

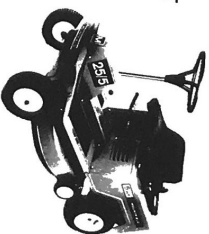

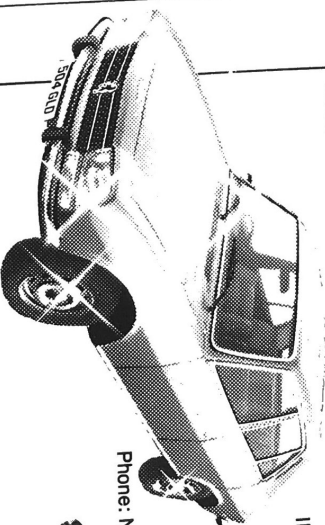

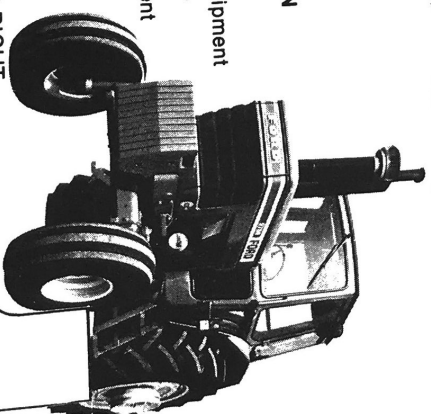

16 Battalion RAOC Close Combat Display Team

The 16 Battalion RAOC Close Combat Display Team was formed six years ago. Its members are all volunteers from the Central Ordnance Depot at Bicester, drawn from such trades as clerks, drivers, storemen and storewomen. Close Combat involves not only unarmed combat, but also defence against such weapons as the knife, club or rifle and bayonet. Each member is trained during the winter in the skills necessary to defend himself against such armed opponents, and during the summer a team is formed to display these skills. This Display Team appears at functions, helping the organizers to attract a reasonable audience, which raises money for a variety of charities.

By inviting contributions from the organizers of the events at which it appears, the Display Team is also able to raise money for its own Battalion Welfare Fund. Thus, in addition to contributing to welfare needs within the Bicester Garrison area, the Team was able to help many deserving causes in the past years.

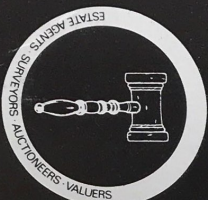
