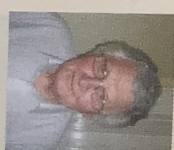

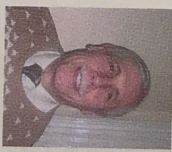
Newport Pagnell Carnival

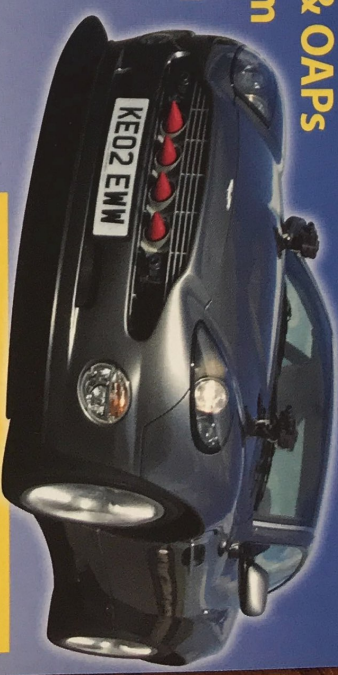
