PARADE ROUTE - 2ND JULY THEME - 60 YEARS OF MEMORIES

The first runners will leave Blakelands at 12pm sharp, to be followed by our family fun run and the parade moments later.

Leaving Tanners Drive, the Parade turns onto Brickhill Street and then takes a right at the Redhouse Park roundabout and onto Wolverton Road.

It continues on to the High Street, before turning right at the mini roundabout (outside the Cannon) and continuing along St. John Street.

Over the Iron Bridge, past Aston Martin Lagonda before turning right onto Severn Drive. Finally finishing at Riverside Meadow (via Dove Close gate).

Roads in and around Newport Pagnell will be closed and/or affected between 11.30am and 1.30pm. Roads will reopen once the parade has passed through. We strongly advise residents along the parade route to plan accordingly around those 2 hours.

PARADE ROUTE - 3RD JULY CLASSIC CAR RALLY

There are no official road closures in effect on the Sunday but there will be a superb collection of beautiful cars and vehicles to watch as they drive through the town.

Leaving Tanners Drive the Parade turns onto Brickhill Street and then takes a right at the Red House Park roundabout and on to Wolverton Road. It continues on to the High Street, before turning right at the mini roundabout (outside the Cannon) and continuing along St. John Street.

Over the Iron Bridge, past Aston Martin Lagonda before turning right onto Severn Drive. Finally finishing at Riverside Meadow (via Dove Close gate).

Please come out and see these magnificent vehicles en route, some traveling many miles to be with us at Carnival. Many of the cars will be on Riverside Meadow if you'd like a closer look or to chat to the owners.

IMPORTANT STUFF PARKING

If you are travelling from afar, free parking is available with direct access to the field via Welland Drive - use the postcode MK16 9DX if you have a sat nav and it should bring you to the right place.

If you're tech savvy the What3words phrase to find the car park is: ///aims.airless.stance

We are the first to admit that the parking isn't the easiest to find, but we have added lots of signage to help so please keep your eyes peeled for the **BLUE** arrows.



PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN THE RESIDENTIAL STREETS, THERE IS ROOM FOR ALL VISITORS ON THE MEADOW.

- Turn onto Severn Drive (By Harben House not Kings Arms)
- Take a left onto Thames Drive
- Take a left again into Wellend Drive
- Follow Wellend Drive until the road forks
- Head left at the fork, there is a gate at the end
- Go through the gate and onto the field to park up



Please drive slowly and cautiously once on the meadow.

GET READY TO RUN!

On Saturday, a fast and flat 5K road race through the historic market town of Newport Pagnell awaits you. On closed roads in front of thousands, you'll be running ahead of the annual town Carnival Parade. The race finishes on the carnival meadow in the show arena where a day of entertainment and fun awaits you.

NEWPORT PAGNELL CARNIVAL 5K (THE 'SERIOUS' ONE)

Open to those aged 11 and above following UKA rules. No buggies, dogs or headphones are allowed. This is the ideal option for those looking to commit themselves to a serious 5K challenge and potential PB.

The 'Serious' One will kick off at 12pm.

NEWPORT PAGNELL CARNIVAL FAMILY 5K (THE FAMILY FUN ONE)

Open to everyone to run, jog, walk, buggy push and enjoy! A fun way to take part in the Carnival 5K with your family and friends.

The family fun run 5K event will head off just after the first 5K event and will follow the same route.

Children under 11 years old must be accompanied by an adult.

You'll start your run in Blakelands Business Park (off Tanners Drive). You'll finish your 5K by following the path around the Carnival Meadow and into the main arena to cross the finish line.


