Entry Forms

- ★ Entry forms can be found on our website at www.newportpagnellcarnival.com
- ★ A space in the rally or in the static display cannot be confirmed until a completed form has been received.
- ★ We recommend all participants submit an entry form as soon as possible. Arrivals on the day (who have not submitted an entry form) will only be permitted onto the field, subject to space availability.
- ★ Confirmation of start time and directions will be sent to you by email at least one week before the Carnival event.

Rally

- ★ If you have opted to take part in the Rally, all vehicles must arrive at Tanners Drive, Blakelands, MK14 5BP, no later than 11:30am. Any vehicles arriving after this time may be unable to participate in the Rally.
- ★ The Rally will run from Blakelands to Riverside Meadow. If you are also taking part in the static car show, please continue into Riverside Meadow via Dove Gate. If you are not taking part in the static car show, please continue along Tickford Street and do not turn into Severn Drive at Harben House.

Static Show

- ★ Cars will be directed to their allocated space upon arrival into Riverside Meadow via Dove Gate.
- ★ Entrants who wish to take part in the static car show but NOT in the Rally are asked to arrive at Riverside Meadow between 10:30am and 11:00am.
- ★ Late arrivals may not be permitted to bring their vehicle onto the field.
- ★ **Vehicles must remain on the meadow for the duration of the day until 16:00** unless otherwise agreed by a member of the Carnival Committee or the Police.
- ★ Due to the high number of pedestrians on the meadow, anyone attempting to move their vehicle prior to the agreed time may be reported and any future request to participate in the event will be declined.
- ★ Vehicle owners should assess the weather and the appropriateness of their vehicle prior to entering the meadow. There is no facility available to tow a vehicle once on site.
- ★ Newport Pagnell Carnival is unable to provide any equipment, such as tables, chairs or gazebos etc. but you are welcome to bring your own equipment.
- ★ Generators of any kind are not permitted.
- ★ Opening times to the public for Carnival Sunday are 12:00-16:00.
- ★ Entrance for participants and spectators is free of charge on Carnival Sunday.

Litter

- ★ All vehicle owners are required to be responsible for their own litter and it is expected that the area is left clear. Litter bins are provided on site and we ask that you use these or take your litter home with you.

Behaviour

- ★ The Carnival Committee will not tolerate any verbal or physical abuse before, during or after the carnival event. Anyone who is deemed to be acting against the spirit of the carnival (either to a committee member, another participant or to a member of the public), will have their application declined, be asked to leave the carnival and/or have all future applications rejected.
